

**CITY OF LARKSPUR  
RESOLUTION 37/22**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LARKSPUR  
CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
OF THREE MEMBERS OF THE LARKSPUR CITY COUNCIL FOR FOUR-YEAR  
TERMS, REQUESTING THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF  
MARIN ORDER THE CONSOLIDATION OF SAID ELECTION WITH ANY OTHER  
ELECTION CONDUCTED ON SAID DATE, AND REQUESTING CERTAIN ELECTION  
SERVICES BY THE COUNTY CLERK**

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**WHEREAS**, three five-year terms of office on the Larkspur City Council will expire on the certification of the November 8, 2022 election results;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 10002 and 10403, the City Council of the City of Larkspur may request the County of Marin Board of Supervisors to permit the County Elections Official to render specified services to the City relating to the conduct of the election on a reimbursable basis.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Larkspur does hereby resolve, declare, determine and order as follows:

1. That an election is hereby called to be held on November 8, 2022, at which election of three City Council seats for a term of four years will be determined.
2. That the consolidated election will be held and conducted in the matter prescribed in Elections Code Section 10418; and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin is hereby requested to consolidate said election with any other applicable election conducted on the same day.
3. That the County Elections Official is authorized, at the City's expense, to provide all necessary election services in order to properly and lawfully conduct said election, including precinct workers and the procurement and furnishing of all official ballots, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election, and to canvass the results of said election.
4. That the polls for the election shall be open at 7:00 a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until 8:00 p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed.
5. That the City of Larkspur acknowledges that the County will bear additional costs by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for any such costs upon the City's receipt of the properly approved invoice.
6. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election in the time, form and manner as required by law.
7. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.
8. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of the resolution with the County of Marin Elections Department.


