City of Larkspur Parks & Recreation Commission Notice of Vacancy

The City of Larkspur is accepting applications for one vacancy on the Parks & Recreation Commission, created by the resignation of Sandy Blauvelt effective August 30, 2022. The individual appointed will serve the remainder of Ms. Blauvelt's term through June 30, 2024.

Applicants must be residents of the City of Larkspur or the portion of Greenbrae under the City of Larkspur's jurisdiction.

The Parks & Recreation Commission formulate plans for development of park and recreation areas, facilities, and activities. They also make recommendations to the City Council on activities within their jurisdiction and supervise and coordinate recreational activities. The Commission also processes requests for the removal of heritage trees.

The Parks & Recreation Commission meets on the third Thursday of each month at 6:30 p.m. in the Larkspur City Council Chambers, 400 Magnolia Ave., Larkspur CA, or virtually via videoconference. Board members are required to complete Ethics Training every two years.
